



Minutes of the General Meeting of the Sun City Grand Republican Special
Interest Group, aka Grand Republicans
June 18, 2022

After the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance, Frank Rizzo announced a raffle being held by LD-29 for a gun (tickets \$10.00 each) or some beef and a freezer (tickets \$20.00)

He also advised that poll workers are needed. Polling centers will be within 2 miles of the district.

LD-29 has meetings the 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Salvation Army. Training for poll workers starts at 5:30 p.m. and the meeting starts at 6:30 p.m. Karrin Robson, Matt Salmon, Paul Gosar and Sandra Dowling will be at the meeting.

Monica Phan from Debbie Lesko's office gave a rundown of what is happening in Washington:

- ✓ Debbie voted NO on HR 7910 Gun Control bill.
- ✓ Commerce bill HR6858 concerning Russian Plan and production of gas is being worked on.
- ✓ HR6688 Family and Small Business Tax cuts. Make tax cuts permanent.
- ✓ Resolution 768 Illegal immigrants: Stop illegal immigration by making them follow immigration laws.
- ✓ Debbie went to the border and detention center in April; said 1,200 pounds of fentanyl came through.

Jan Shank advised that:

- The July meeting would have Jim Lamon, Karrin Robson, Justin Olson and Susan Black.

- August 20 2022 will be our big meeting at Vista Hall with all the winners of the primary plus the Chief of Police, the Mayor, former Governor Jan Brewer and AZ Republican Club Chairwoman, Kelli Ward. Our featured speaker will be Charlie Kirk. Tickets will be free to members of SCG and Pebble Creek Republican Clubs. Three weeks prior it will be open to the public if it is not sold out.
- September speaker will be Lawrence Spiveck, Free Market Warrior: "How we fight to understand the left and why they contradict themselves."
- Seth Leibsohn will speak on *Rules for Radicals* by Saul Alinsky and how they come into play today.

Mitch McGuire - his main things to keep in mind are always paradigm, faith, family and duty:

- a. Faith is something bigger than yourself. It is an energy he gets at the time of fear and despair for the Army and the country. He asks God to help and feels he hears him.
- b. We need the family to save the republic.
- c. Duty: on January 6 he was asked to send in troops to assist. He said no as it was illegal. He was the only one that did that but eventually 42 or the 53 generals joined him and recalled troops.

Border is our biggest problem: Must complete wall and installation of surveillance equipment.

Main issues, abortion, states' rights, 2nd amendment

Attorney General Candidate Tiffany Shedd:

- Major emphasis on illegal aliens.
- She wants to protect the rights of all Arizonans.
- She has an issue with the US Dept of the Interior over a 2.8 acre shortage of water from the Colorado River. We could lose 1/3 of our water.
- There is a lack of leadership in AZ on energy.
- She went to the border and for 90 miles from the border they found backpacks and carpet shoes. She is afraid of an invasion by military age males who are coming with these backpacks and carpet shoes. What can the government do? Just pass human smuggling, sex trafficking laws. These traffickers use Facebook, twitter and snapchat.

Rachel Mitchel, candidate for County Attorney (In other states it is called District Attorney):

- 1) We have a hotel in Scottsdale for illegals!
- 2) She has spent 25 of her 30-year career protecting children.
- 3) Primary prosecutor for felonies in Maricopa County.

AZ Corporation Commission - Kim Owens

Power and responsibility of commission: Regulate breach of state government, cross judicial and legislative regulations New corporation flags, railroad crossing safety, utilities, gas, water, telecom She advised to speak up if you see something that is wrong. That is why she was on the school board for 5 terms. Water and power, work with landowners and other states. Would never regulate rates or switch to policy like California.

Chris Moler - Justice of the Peace - Has limited jurisdiction Different from Superior Court Routine lower level juris like traffic tickets, DUI's, harassment, evictions from rental property. Believes in the public and in term limits so stayed away for 2 terms and returned to help public
