



General Meeting June 17, 2023 Minutes

After the invocation and the pledge of allegiance, the meeting was opened by President Phil Axelrod at 9:30 a.m.

Susan Black, AZ House candidate from LD-28, was introduced and spoke for a few minutes. She is a conservative Republican who has been on the Board of a Charter school for five years. She has been a local Precinct Committeeman for two years.

She believes we have an invasion at the border and that we need to fight the cartels and stop all the drugs being brought to the USA.

Frank Rizzo advised that Guns Plus is having Basic Senior Self Defense training at the West Valley office on Wednesday night 21st of June. LD-29 will be sponsoring CCW classes with them in the near future. Class attendees can rent pistols for \$20 for CCW classes.

If you have CCW you can cross state lines into cooperating States and into restaurants and bars that serve alcohol as long as you don't drink.

Frank is also a member of a safety group that sits in the back of the COTG on Sunday and Prince of Peace Church on Saturday armed to protect worshipers if necessary.

LD-29 having an election for 3rd Vice Chair with PC's only admitted. LD29 will be dark for July and August.

Debbie Lesko's Congressional District 8 office has helped 800,000 people with social security, IRS, passport problems etc. She is on the Energy and Commerce committee. She worked to save the gas stoves and sponsored the bill passed. 40 million people in the USA have gas stoves. Biden is trying to destroy all oil industries. Debbie is trying to get Joe Manchin to vote in the Senate for the bill.

In North Carolina someone shot out two power stations and the power was out for five days to 45,000 people.

The House is trying to pass a border security bill.

House Republicans worked to cut the spending bill Biden put forth and succeeded in cutting it \$4.8 billion over 10 years. They cut the amount of IRS agents, and they worked on cutting out student loan forgiveness. They have a work requirement for government benefits.

Biden got waver on the homeless, as they will not have to work for benefits.

Trump indictment in the Judiciary Committee:

- Democrats using false collusion against his campaign.
- The Durham report showed so many problems and that we have a two-prong system of justice. The left wants to make it so Trump doesn't run for President.
- Trump can be his own worst enemy, but he has done a lot for our country.

Need to go after Biden with all his classified documents in many locations.

Jan Shank reminded members that we have a website, grandrepublicans.com, where the monologue from Seth Leibson on what is wrong with the school system can be found.

Our main speaker, County Attorney Rachel Mitchel, talked about how laws are implemented. Her office has 1,000 employees, 350 prosecutors, 50 civil attorneys.

There are 55,775 charges to be filed.

George Soros wants this office, as it is one of the few in the county not controlled by him. He paid \$1.3 million to get his choices elected.

There are over 10,000 charges not worked on; 800 DUI's and 59 officer shootings that have to be litigated.

Since she has been in office they have reduced the backlog of cases by 57.2% plus took care of all 800 DUI's and the 59 police cases are all being worked on.

She has reorganized how trials are processed. She meets regularly with all police chiefs. They arrested over 500 people on drugs. They took 46 guns from 21 people in five days. You can contact her at Maricopacountyattorneysoffice.org. She believes in the death penalty and capital litigation.

Some of the things her office is working on include: Homicide, drug trafficking, white collar crime, family violators, sex crimes, gangs, vehicular crime, and higher bail are on some of the things they are working on. One of her top priorities is retail crime. The man who killed the two ladies who were jogging just got the death penalty and she believes he got what he deserved. She believes offenders should stay in jail and not be let out. Hobbs vetoed a bill proposing this.

She asked for attorney fees to be paid back in cases such as Kari Lake vs Hobbs. She has a federal court order to use paper ballots for elections. George Soros wants no bail, they want to target police, release prisoners and not prosecute certain offenders, and the Democrats want to reduce police force. She is fighting against all this. She wants to have electronic printers tested internally to prevent fraud. Rachael would like to have security guards in all schools.

After a 15-minute question-and-answer session and 50-50 drawing, the meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
