



Minutes of the General Meeting April 15, 2023

President Phil Axelrod called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Prior to the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance, a Patriotic Video, "Images of Patriotism," was played.

Frank Rizzo advised that another gun raffle is being held, with the drawing next Tuesday. Tickets are \$10.00 each, with the money going to LD29 for on-going expenses.

Frank announced that Representative Steve Montenegro has been invited to Florida to talk with President Trump about the border.

Frank also announced that Nick Danison has been invited to the LD29 meeting to set up a series of speaking engagements for them and anyone that wishes to come.

1st VP Jan Shank introduced the main speaker, Shelby Busch, Chairman of We the People Alliance, and an active member and speaker. Their purpose is to hold elected officials accountable to the constitution.

As Chairman, Ms Busch was a driving force behind the 2022 Election and has provided bombshell testimony before the Senate Committee on Elections. Her findings, including Signature Verification and Voting Machine Failures, have put over 500,000 2022 Election Ballots in question.

The We the People Alliance officially came into being in 2019, but have been working for over a decade. They have over 4,000 volunteers.

Adrienne Fontes, Secretary of State: In 2018 he opened emergency polling locations in Democrat centers which were set up to harvest votes and voters did not need ID to vote there. He was responsible for counting voter ballots that were in error. He counted thousands of torn ballots. It was thought that three conservatives won, but ended up losing because of ballot count.

Stephen Richer ran against Adrienne Fontes. There was a problem with the size of the election paper and Scott Jarrett said that 17,000 ballots were okay even though the size was wrong. Even though there is a video of Jarrett's person going into the polling center looking at ballots, Jarrett said they will analyze the situation, and nothing has been done. There were 11 polling systems influenced. They changed the rules of voting midstream.

The Election Assistance Commission certified that Maricopa County had 220 polling centers. There was a 46.7% failure rate for ballots going through. Some failure rates were as high as 90%. There was little review on mail-in ballots signatures. They tended to compare those they did review with the last election instead of the registration form. There were thousands of names and signatures that did not match.

The county said they could compare one signature every 8 seconds. If they had 24-hour workers not eating, sleeping or going to the bathroom, it would take 30.4 seconds to verify one signature, so you can see they couldn't verify signatures in 8 seconds. There are two voters disenfranchised for every fraudulent ballot. Voter drop boxes were a major source of fraud with people videoed dropping thousands of ballots in a box and going to another box to drop more. There were 181,378 voter signature problems.

Ballot curing on mail-in ballot: The Signatures do not match so they have to check with the voter to see if it is the same person or not. There were 1,870 of these in the last election. County approved incorrect signatures five days after election day.

There were 542 signatures that were not the voters' signatures. There were 18,000 problems with signatures on provisional ballots. 783 people voted that were new registrants who didn't register until after the election.

Rock the Vote, a leftist non-profit motor-voter: Here in AZ, you can register to vote by just getting a driver license at the MVD. Everyone with a driver license can vote.

Abe Hamadeh was only 280 votes from being Attorney General. There are thousands of provisional ballots to be investigated with such things as "You voted in Maricopa County, but your name came up as voting in Pinal County, so it didn't count. Voter rolls are the biggest problem and must be corrected. Thousands of dead people still voting; moved to another part of the country and still on the Arizona voting rolls. Also, people voting from business addresses which are not legal, ballots that are "not deliverable" being delivered anyway.

We the People Alliance is looking for help to research many of the signature ballots. Can be done from home or at their facility, and they will train you.

VRL Program offered by non-profit organizations to access a direct portal into the registration system. Letting nonprofits run registration. They get voter ID and registration info so they can harvest votes when voter ballots go out. There were 10,001 tabulated and missing ballots that showed up. 4,027 cleaned, 3,484 suspicious, 2,438 high probability of fraud

How can we help? Digital canvassing - signature verification, PC help by getting to know neighbors talking to them and answering questions, funding. Need to get with the mail-in- ballot system.
